mASCot supports local families from the Brighton and Hove area.

Families benefit greatly from being able to share their experiences and swap strategies and knowledge with each other as well as having access to many projects.

mASCot is a resource that is always available, there are many opportunities for families to learn, socialise, access therapies and to take part in activities that are all specially geared for those living with ASC.

mASCot is all about celebrating wonderful diverse families and allowing children to be themselves whilst learning the skills to grow and thrive in the world as well as supporting parent on their journey.

More of what they do

mASCot has evolved over the years and now has over 2100 members, which equates to between 4000-6000 individuals supported in the mASCot community.

mASCot has a hardworking Director team and a committed group of parents who help run clubs and activities, all of whom have a child/children or young adults who is autistic.

mASCot works hard to improve the services and provisions for ASC children within B&H but also actively facilitates many projects for children and families themselves, they are always planning new projects which include activities, talks, clubs, workshops and meet ups for mASCot children and families.

All fundraising for mASCot goes towards our projects which benefit our families directly, The newest projects we have started and need funding for is our Equine Therapy and our Girls group which are both run locally in Portslade.
